Township News

The closed bridge on Eager Road north of M59 is now scheduled for reconstruction in 2018. In 2018 the Livingston County Road Commission is partnering with Oceola to begin the realignment of Eager Road at M59 so that MDOT will install a regular traffic light at that intersection. These two changes should greatly improve the traffic flow on Eager and Bigelow Roads.

New Election Equipment

Oceola Township is participating in a statewide election grant, HAVA, and has received new voting equipment which we will begin using in the 2018 election cycle. The vendor chosen by the Livingston County Clerk is Hart InterCivic, a US supplier that has designed the voting equipment to meet the State of Michigan's specific requirements. Hart InterCivic's state-of-the-art technology is designed to make the voting process both simple and secure for all voters. We look forward to using the new voting machines in Oceola Township elections in 2018.

Oceola Park

We are applying for a grant to help out with the next phase of the Oceola Park. This phase will provide a new play structure for children in the two-to-five-year-old range. Construction is set to begin in the spring of 2018.

Beginning in late April 2018, all Oceola Township residents can pick up two (2) vehicle passes per residence to enter Howell City Park & Boat Launch for free. The passes are required from May 1 through October 31 for free use of the facilities.

Passes can be picked up at the Bennett Recreation Center located at 925 West Grand River Avenue beginning in late April, between the hours of 9-5 Monday—Friday.

Oceola residents also receive a discounted price when they pay to participate in the various programs HAPRA offers.
